Mary Sennewald recently returned to the States after serving as an accompanier to massacre survivors in the Ixil region of Guatemala. The Copper Country Guatemala Accompaniment Project is sponsoring a public presentation at which Mary will speak about her experiences among indigenous people whose lives have been marked by genocidal violence. Many of these indigenous people continue to be targeted by the state because of their resistance to the takeover of their land and resources by corporate interests. Mary is a journalist and author; she will be bringing along copies of her book Road-schooling Ryan, a memoir of her year on the road with her high-school-age son.
